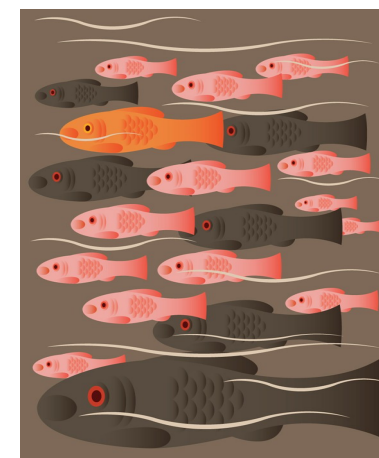


Sometimes small towns hold the biggest secrets.
