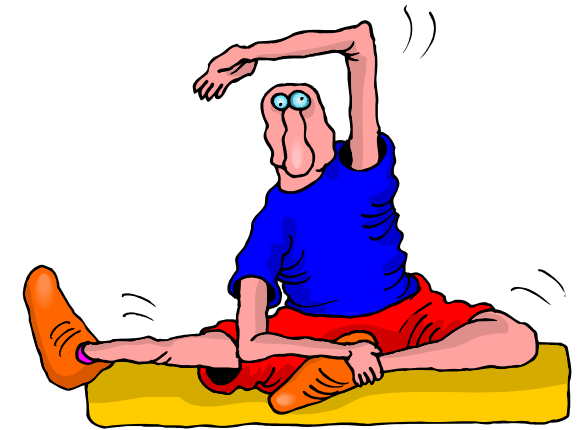

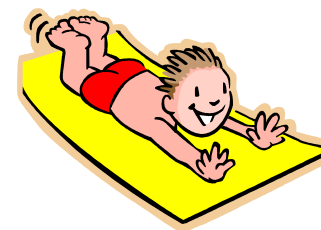
School Supplies
