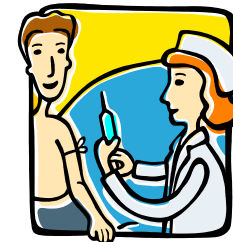

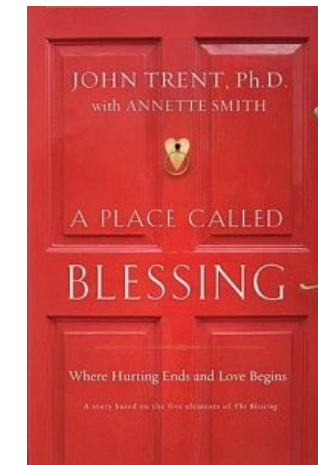
The Health Department will provide drive through flu shots in the back parking lot of FBC. Bring your insurance, Medicaid or Medicare card.

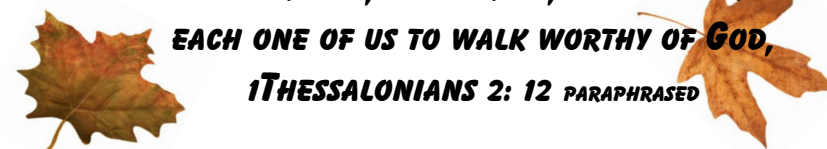
